

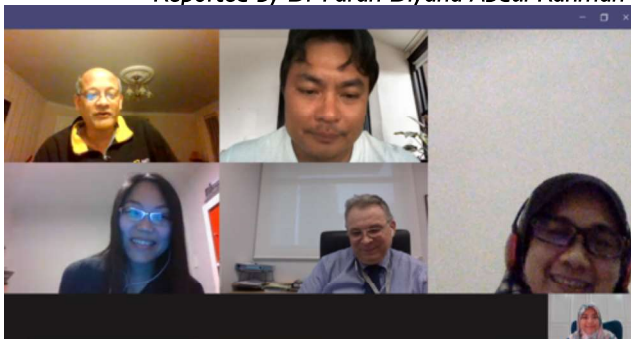

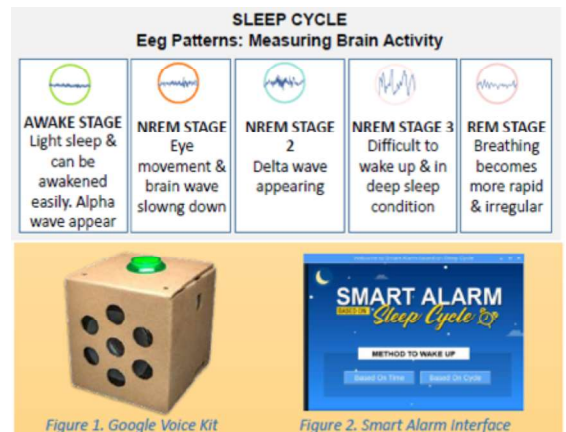

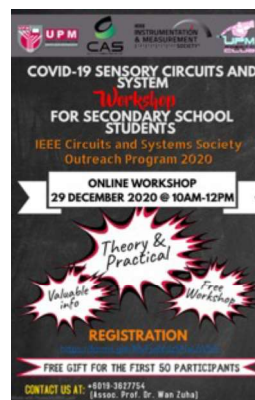
2020 IEEE IMS Final Year Project Award at IIUM

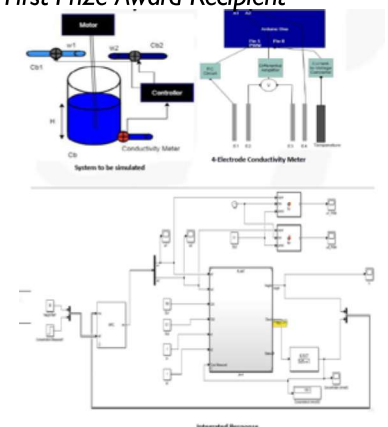
